My Name is **J. Melinda Christoph**, and I will be your child's **ESE Intensive Reading teacher**. The purpose of this course is to provide intensive instruction in reading concepts and skills to enable students with disabilities to function at their highest levels and prepare to participate effectively in post-school adult living and the world of work.

Our classroom environment is highly structured. Students will begin class with a daily warm-up and then move into a lesson that is teacher directed. Students will then work in groups, one-on-one with me, or individually. Students will work on Comprehension, Fluency, and Vocabulary every day. Quizzes will be given every Friday and a Test will be given at the end of each term. In addition, students will have homework three times per week.

Since this class is highly structured, it is important that you help your child stay organized and focused on the assignments so they do not fall behind. **Students are required to have a 2 inch binder with clear plastic cover by the third day of class.** This binder will stay in the classroom to keep notes, assignments, readings logs, and FCAT information. Students will also be able to use their binders for tests and quizzes.
